DEAR PARENTS/RIDERS:

We hope everyone had a fun Halloween!

If you are a part of the horse world during the month of November, you will eventually hear about No Stirrup November. Here at Magnolia we believe that no stirrups work should build confidence and a correct position rather than being a 'time of torture.' We believe in having riders add in 5 - 10 min of no stirrups work at the beginning or end of their lesson as part of their normal routine, instead of going crazy in November. Start doing just a few minutes at a time and slowly build up. Only do as long as you can stay in the correct position because there is no point in working without stirrups if you're just bouncing around in the wrong position.

We are busy planning and preparing to join the winter show circuit at WEC and Wellington.

We will be closed on Thurs 11/24 for Thanksgiving Day. If you would like a makeup, we would be happy to schedule one.

YES, we will have lessons the entire week of Thanksgiving except for Thanksgiving Day. Please let us know if you will be absent from your lesson during Thanksgiving week, or if you'd like to schedule a makeup.

TO BOARDERS:

Please plan with Emma about holding your horse if they are being seen by the farrier.

If you are planning to take your horse from the property for shows etc. Please contact Emma 7 days in advance of your horse leaving property to arrange grain and hay preparation. We like to make it as easy as possible to have your horse leave and return from the farm.

Reminder about blanketing. If your horse is clipped the temperatures are in the 50 - 65 degree range in the evening. Please bring a sheet to have on your horse.
