## WELCOME JESSICA UMBERGER TO OUR INSTRUCTOR TEAM

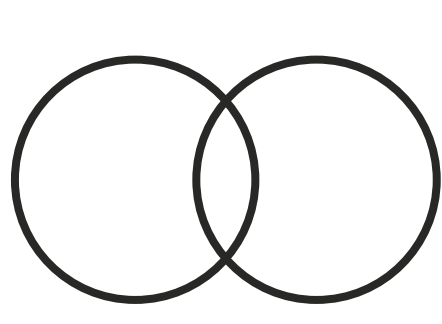
