REMINDERS

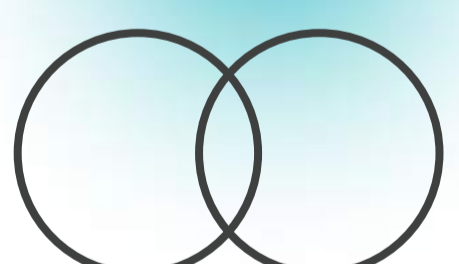


A FEW REMINDERS FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL OUR RIDERS. HORSES BY NATURE ARE PREY ANIMALS WE WANT TO DO EVERYTHING WE CAN TO ENSURE EVERYONE'S SAFETY.

- Only riders are allowed in the barns and tack-up areas. If the rider is under 8 years old, a parent may stay with them.
- Young children must be supervised. Keep young children quiet. No games involving fast movements, loud noises or balls.

Spectators may watch from the designated viewing areas. Do not walk around the arenas while lessons are in session.

- Only riders are permitted in the paddocks. No parents in paddocks or catching horses.
- No smoking or vaping.
- Do not bring pets to Magnolia Acres Farm during a lesson. Horses are instinctively prey animals, and many are wary of strange dogs regardless of the dog's size. You will be asked to bring the pet home. No running or sudden movements.
- Do not use umbrellas, flash cameras, noisy electronics or toys while horses are present. If it rains and you need to open an umbrella be mindful of where you open the umbrella preferably not close to a horse as they are walking with a rider.
- No shouting, squealing or loud noises. This includes loud talking, laughing, and calling to the Student Rider. Horses do startle from unexpected noises, and we want to keep our Student Riders and Riding Instructors safe.



TUITION

All Tuition is due at the 1st of the month and should be paid by the 5th to avoid a \$25 late fee and the whole month should be paid in full at that time.
