If you are riding more than once/week or have questions about our sibling/family discount, let us know and we can inform you what your rate is.



Reminders


Payment is due at the 1st of the month and late on the 7th and the whole month should be paid in full at that time.

Tuition still needs to be paid by the 6th of the month even if you are not lessoning between those dates.

Returned payment fee of \$25.00 will be applied for any NSF items.

If taking an extended vacation, we can withdraw the rider from lessons but can't guarantee the same lesson time slot will be held for when the student is able to return to lessons.

If you plan to discontinue/take a break from lessons 30 days advance notice is requested or you will be billed for the next month's session.



CANCELLATION/MAKEUP POLICY

Reminder for the school year, we do require make-ups for any lessons missed or you forfeit the cost of that lesson. Since your lesson reserves time with your instructor and a spot on the lesson schedule, we require that you cancel any lessons you cannot attend at least 24 hours before the start of the class. Coming regularly to class is important and will help you grow as a rider.

Lessons cancelled with **less than 24 hours' notice or no calls/no shows** will be charged full price for the missed lesson. We understand illness and emergencies happen so please communicate with your instructor.

Riders that miss 2 lessons in a row without notice or excuse may lose their weekly spot should instructor have a waitlist for vacancies. If running late to a lesson please contact us, riders more than 15 minutes late with no notice will be marked absent from the lesson and the lesson will be forfeited.

For riders needing to cancel or reschedule their lesson, a make-up lesson will be given to be used within 14 days of the missed lesson. It is the rider's responsibility to contact us once the instructor has reached out to you via text and offered make up spots. If your instructor has reached out to you via text to get the lesson rescheduled more than once and there is no response, the lesson will be forfeited, and a make-up not offered. Should a rider choose to forgo a make-up lesson, no lesson credit will be given for the missed lesson. Make-up classes may be taken in any available class at rider's current skill level. Should riders choose not to attend make-up lesson accommodations offered by stable, no lesson credit will be given for the missed lesson. Saturday make-up lessons are extremely limited and may not be available depending on season. Unpaid spots will not be held in the event of student's absence for any reason.

Lessons will be held **rain or shine** unless cancelled by instructor. If instructor cancels lessons for any reason, including severe weather, students will be given a make-up lesson to be used within the same parameters outlined above. In the event that classes are cancelled, students will be notified via text message. Thank you for your understanding.

Please note that in the event stable is closed for competitions or holidays, make-up lessons will be given for any displaced classes.

Tuition Box

A tuition box is now located inside the blue barn to the **left of the tack/office door**.

Please place all checks and cash in this secure box.

Construction Update

Please continue to be patient and careful while we are improving our lesson facility and construction is progressing. We are expecting to have all construction completed by the **end of February**. It will bring us an additional 4 covered wash racks, additional arena lights and facility lighting, a larger front covered porch and entrance to blue barn, all our stalls now have stall mattresses, a new boarding barn and a restroom located inside the blue barn.

Visitors

If you bring a visitor to the farm please stop by the office first for a liability release to be signed. We require everyone on property to have a signed release on file.
