As the weather is getting extremely hot we encourage all riders to hydrate the night before you plan to ride or attend any camps/clinics. Body Armour, Gatorade, or Biolyte are excellent choices. We understand at times it is a challenge to get children to drink the necessary fluids but it is better to encourage drinking than have them dehydrated, vomiting, or with nose bleeds here at the farm.



A reminder that our summer lesson schedule does change, and we do take the month of July off from lessons. So, there will be no lessons for all riders during the month of July, we will return for the 2024-2025 riding season on August 5.



We will soon talk about lesson time availability for your rider for the 2024-2025 riding season. If you have any requests, please make them by July 29 to Kim Haley.
