

Welcome to the 2024-2025 riding season. We are excited to see what this new season holds for Magnolia and all our riders. All lessons begin on Monday, Aug 5. Your instructor should have been in contact with you to finalize lessons times. We look forward to seeing everyone on Monday.

It is still extremely hot outside. Prepare for that by hydrating before your lessons. Drinking gatorade, propel, or biolyte are excellent ways to hydrate with electrolytes. Last year we had a few riders almost pass out due to dehydration combined with the heat. It is best to start hydrating the night before a lesson.

We will be asking all riders in the riding academy to purchase a polo to be worn while lessoning this year. Once the Magnolia online store is open, we will offer a 10% discount for the first week on your total purchase. More details will follow.

an approved helmet.

CANCELLATION/MAKEUP POLICY

Reminder for the school year, we do require make-ups for any lessons missed or you forfeit the cost of that lesson. Since your lesson reserves time with your instructor and a spot on the lesson schedule, we require that you cancel any lessons you cannot attend at least 24 hours before the start of the class. Coming regularly to class is important and will help you grow as a rider. Lessons cancelled with less than 24 hours' notice or no calls/no shows will be charged full

Considerable time goes into planning lessons with instructors and reserving horses for

riders, therefore it is the responsibility of the rider to come to lessons and be on time.

communicate with your instructor. Riders that miss 2 lessons in a row without notice or excuse may lose their weekly spot should instructor have a waitlist for vacancies.

price for the missed lesson. We understand illness and emergencies happen so please

If running late to a lesson please contact us, riders more than 15 minutes late with no notice will be marked absent from the lesson and the lesson will be forfeited. Unpaid spots will not be held in the event of rider's absence for any reason.

For riders needing to cancel or reschedule their lesson, a make-up lesson will be given to be used within 14 days of the missed lesson. It is the rider's responsibility to contact us once the instructor has reached out to you via text and offered make up spots. If your instructor has

reached out to you via text to get the lesson rescheduled more than once and there is no response, the lesson will be forfeited, and a make-up not offered. Should a rider choose to forgo a make-up lesson, no lesson credit will be given for the missed lesson. Make-up classes may be taken in any available class. It is not guaranteed that it will be at the rider's current skill level. Should riders choose not to attend make-up lesson accommodations offered by stable, no lesson credit will be given for the missed lesson. Saturday make-up lessons are extremely limited and may not be available depending on the season. Unpaid spots will not be held in the event of rider's absence for any reason. **Lessons** will be held rain or shine unless cancelled by instructor. If the lesson must be moved

to an unmounted lesson due to rain and you choose to not attend the lesson a make-up lesson will not be offered. We believe unmounted lessons are just as important if not more important than mounted lessons and encourage all our riders to take advantage of this

Please note that in the event stable is closed for competitions or holidays,


If you bring a visitor to the facility, please stop by the office first for a liability release to be signed. We require everyone on
